



I am excited to look ahead- to plan for and pursue the vision that God has provided for our association as we serve Him together. My role of Associational Mission Strategist includes identifying and setting goals, then implementing strategies to fulfill the mission. A goal can also be called an objective, purpose, intention, or desire. My mind often goes to big ideas and grand plans. It is good to dream big. But sometimes I notice that I get ahead of myself and lose sight of what is foundational and most important.

In Philippians 3:12-14, Paul reflects on where he is in life and offers some helpful insight for the pursuit of goals:

¹² Not that I have already reached the goal or am already perfect, but I make every effort to take hold of it because I also have been taken hold of by Christ Jesus. ¹³ Brothers and sisters, I do not consider myself to have taken hold of it. But one thing I do: Forgetting what is behind and reaching forward to what is ahead, ¹⁴ I pursue as my goal the prize promised by God's heavenly call in Christ Jesus.

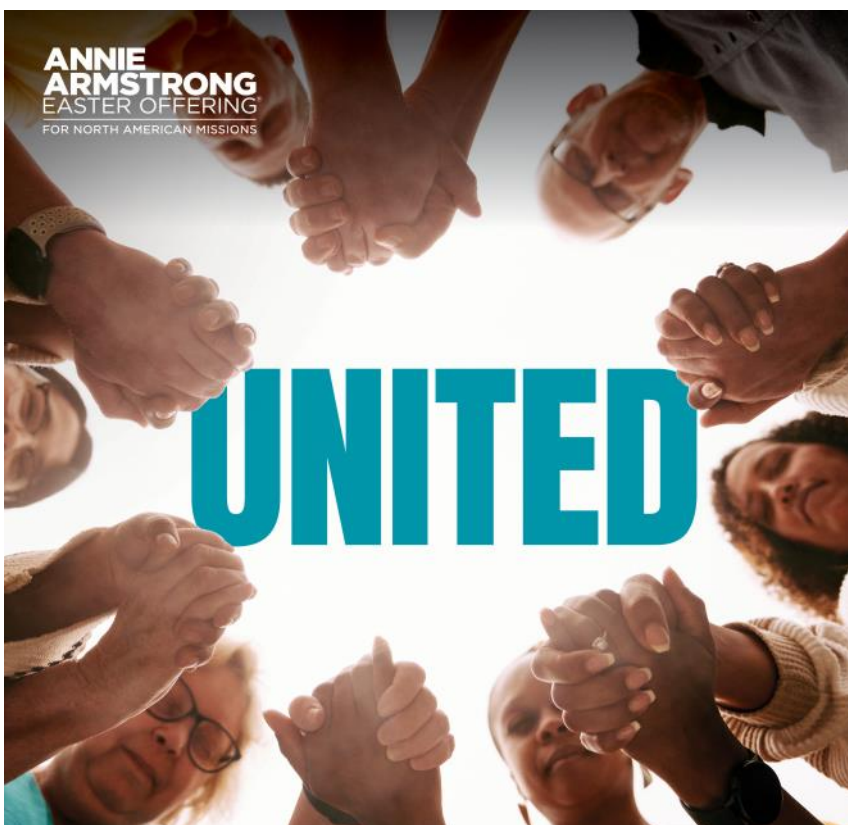
Paul is instructing and exhorting us to focus on what is most important, reaching for (straining toward) the right goal. The **goal** mentioned here is identified in v.10-11 ***"My goal is to know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death, assuming that I will somehow reach the resurrection from among the dead."***

The goal is to know Him! To know Jesus more fully, more intimately; becoming more like Him. Paul sees this as an ongoing process. He recognizes that he has not gotten there yet, and he is encouraging us to press on and pursue this as well.

In the days ahead, you will hear more from the CBA office about mission, vision, and strategy as we strive to be a "movement of churches on mission together." But my first goal, the one from which all other goals will flow, is to **know Him** more fully. This is my commitment to you as I serve our Lord and His church. I ask you to join me in this pursuit, motivated by Jesus' words as recorded in Matthew 6:33: *"But seek first the kingdom of God and his righteousness, and all these things will be added to you."*

I am praying for each of you as we **partner together to fulfill the Great Commission.**

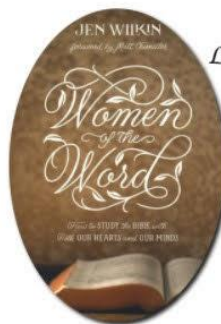
