



What riles you up? What stirs your heart so strongly that what is on the inside bursts forth with outward action? Should a follower of Christ get angry and take action because of it?

In the account of the “cleansing of the temple” found in Matthew 21, we see in verse 12 that Jesus was passionately moved to action- some would even say angry!

And Jesus entered the temple and drove out all who sold and bought in the temple, and he overturned the tables of the money-changers and the seats of those who sold pigeons.

Jesus turned over the tables and drove these people out. The word for “drove” here is the same word as when he cast out a demon. It is a strong word! Jesus means business! But understand this clearly, Jesus never sinned. We call it righteous anger, and He acted appropriately. There are times that we should be angry, but we must submit our feelings and emotions under the power of the Holy Spirit so that we do not react in a sinful manner.

Psalm 4:4-5 *Be angry, and do not sin; ponder in your own hearts on your beds and be silent. Offer right sacrifices and put your trust in the Lord.*

Ephesians 4:26 *In your anger do not sin.*

Early church father John Chrysostom said this about anger: “He that is angry without cause sins; but he who is not angry when there is cause sins.”

There are plenty of things that can stir our hearts in this way - the atrocities that are taking place in Ukraine (and many other areas that are not getting the same attention); the political/cultural/social issues of the day. Our hearts should be stirred, and at appropriate times in appropriate ways we should take action.

Zeal- passion for a particular cause. We see the zeal of Jesus for His Father’s house and for pure worship. What are you zealous about? What are you passionate about?

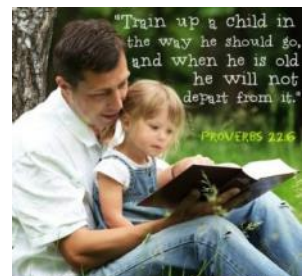

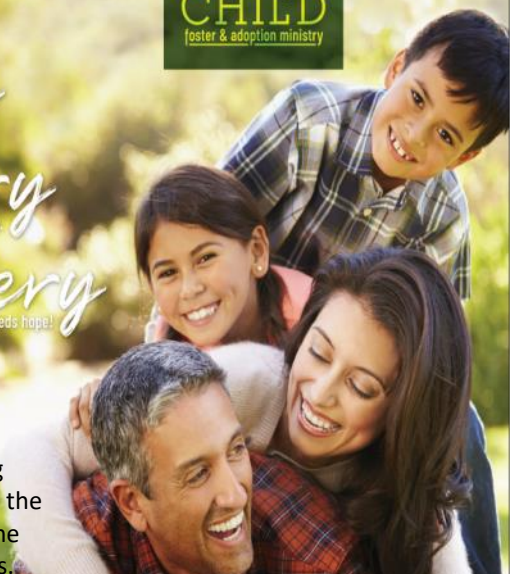
