## Request for a DI Missions Team

If your church or ministry is interested in having a DI Missions team serve with you during your local camp week this summer, please look over the following information, and complete the form on the next page. Please submit one form per project request.

### Teams

Our mission teams are made up of students in 6<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades and their adult leaders. Students are hosted at one site during the camp week, and for them, this is both a mission trip and a camp week. As such, they are on mission sites four days during the week, usually from 9:00am until 2:30pm. Some camp weeks involve a free afternoon for our participants. This occurs on the third day of projects. On this day, project times are adjusted to 9:00am until 12:00pm. The following are the project areas that DI offers to our participants. **The DI Mission Team will be available to do projects in Henderson County Tuesday, June 21-Friday, June 24, 2022.** Tues., Wed., & Fri. are full days; Thurs. is a half day.

### Project Types

**Children's Ministry:** Work with children in a variety of settings, sharing the gospel through VBS-style activities, in addition to other possible methods.

**Construction:** Work in areas of construction, painting, landscaping to help someone in need. Examples include debris cleanup, accessibility ramps, drywall work, etc.

**Sports and Recreation:** Use sports camps, recreation centers, among other methods to share the gospel in the community.

**Senior Adult Ministry:** Work with seniors in the community. Examples include nursing homes, senior centers, life enrichment centers, and special needs adults.

**Community Outreach:** Use acts of kindness to earn the opportunity to share the gospel. Examples include free laundry, water distribution, car washed, etc.

### Supplies

For many projects, DI Missions will supply any materials that are needed. With that said, if your ministry or church group would like to supply some materials, that contribution is welcomed, especially on construction projects.
