

THE KURDS



CBA'S ADOPTED PEOPLE GROUP
PLEASE JOIN US IN PRAYER FOR THE KURDISH PEOPLE



The Kurdish Peoples are one of the largest people groups without a formal country, with 30-45 million estimated to live in several different countries.



The Kurdish People are 99.9% Muslims. They live in an area with lots of biblical history and yet many have never had the opportunity to hear the Gospel.



The Kurdish People have the most presence in Iraq and Turkey, with a very strong presence in the Northern Iraqi providences of: Dohuk, Erbil, and Sulaymaniyah.



The Kurdish People face constant discrimination, even today. During the 1980's it is estimated that over 180,000 Iraqi Kurds were killed in Iraq under Saddam Hussein.



Due to several different factors (religion, discrimination, etc.) many Kurds, especially women, do not know how to read or have been denied an education.

Minutes of the CBA 146th Spring Meeting
April 25, 2023 – 7pm
East Flat Rock First Baptist Church

Welcome and Prayer - Brandon McMinn, Pastor at East Flat Rock First Baptist Church, opened the meeting in prayer and welcomed all the attendees.

Associational Operations - Ray Brickhouse, Moderator of the Leadership Team at CBA and Pastor at Oak Forest Baptist Church, called the business meeting into session.

He then recognized new Pastors and Staff and asked them to introduce themselves and share some information about them with those present.

- Kevin Long, Crab Creek Baptist Church welcomed Kevin as full-time January 29, 2023. Kevin is married to Natalie Long and they have one son. (Kevin was not present at the Spring Semi-Annual meeting).
- Brandon McMinn, East Flat Rock First Baptist Church welcomed Brandon McMinn as full-time pastor January 16, 2023. Brandon is married to Brianna.
- Scott Westmoreland, Etowah Baptist welcomed Scott as full-time pastor April 16, 2023. Scott is married to Teresa and they have one daughter and granddaughter.

Ray then presented the following Leadership Team and Team Leaders for affirmation. Tony Halford (Pastor at Mountain View Baptist) made the motion to affirm the leadership as presented, Tony Reese (Pastor at Saluda First) seconded, there was no opposition, motion was carried. With the exception of Keris Suttles, who will be rotating off as CBA Clerk in October, all team members will continue in their role for the 2023-2024 year.



Financial Report - Paula Janes, Office Manager/CBA presented the Financial Report. As this was a report for information only, no voting was necessary. Ray opened the floor for a question and answer session. There were none so he called the business meeting out of session.

Message - Collin Terenzini, Pastor at Shaws Creek Baptist Church, gave the message from Nehemiah 1:1-4. The question of the evening was "Can God bring dead things back to life"? He shared that upright ministers of the faith have bended knees. Our prayers have to be active, not passive; is God your steering wheel or spare tire? Don't ask God to bless your ministry if you don't think He can.

Associational Mission Strategist Report

- Currie recognized the following faithful servants:
 - Becky Wuerzer, WOC Leader from September 2020 to April 2023 and introduced Summer Cannon who will be leading the WOC Team.
 - Rev. Dewey Barnwell is retiring as pastor of Beulah Church. Pastor Barnwell has been faithfully serving as pastor for 33 years.
 - Rev. Sam Gibbs who passed April 22, 2023. Sam served for 15 years as Director of Church and Community Missions.
- Currie referenced Jeremiah 1:9-10 as his theme verse. He emphasized that we continue to reconstruct, but with a spiritual blue print.
- Foundation: Mission and Vision:
 - Mission: Partnering together to fulfill the Great Commission, Matthew 28:18-20.
 - Vision: Currie pointed out that his title & responsibilities are seen in this vision: Associational Mission Strategist; As an association of Baptist churches in Henderson County, the CBA will intentionally work together to increase missional awareness & accelerate strategic mobilization for the Great Commission through church planting & revitalization, leadership development, local & international community engagement, and ministry partnership formation with Gospel-centered organizations.
 - Strategy #1 focus is Church Strengthening; referencing Ephesians 3: 7-10. The CBA's strategic emphasis will be focused on strengthening our churches and will continue partnering together to fulfill the Great Commission.
 - Church strengthen plans in progress and next steps:
 - Pastor & wives support; healthy leaders-healthy churches
 - Revitalization cohort of pastors
 - Bi-vocational/smaller church support – accessibility to tools & resources to stay on mission
 - Mission insight – understanding our community, customized for each church, available now
 - Strategy #2 is Community Engagement plans in progress and next steps:
 - Targeted communication from CBA office on ways to connect & engage with opportunities
 - Joining in on existing work taking place through NCBOM, NCMB, IMB (On Mission Together booklet).
 - Disaster Relief training opportunities; FBCH May 20th.
 - Structure: CBA Leadership Team – our structure is designed to support our strategy. This is the blueprint for reconstruction. The foundation does not change (gospel, mission). The structure (organization, configuration, strategy plans) will continue to be adjusted.

Currie then showed the NC Missions Offering video and explained the importance of this offering.

Certificates were given out to the top 3 NCMO giving churches:

1. First Baptist Church Hendersonville
2. First Baptist Church Saluda
3. East Flat Rock First Baptist

Community Engagement

Missions and Ministry Report – Rebecca Moon thanked the churches for their support and emphasized that the association could not serve the community without the help of the churches. She referred them to page 9 of the agenda where the ministries of the CBA were listed. She then went on to show the similarities of profit and loss in secular business and Christian outreach. In a business profit and loss is based on revenue in and out; in Christian ministry profit and loss is based on people who accept Jesus Christ as their savior (profit) and those who do not (loss). Christians have been commissioned to share the gospel far and wide and our bottom line should reflect a profit not a loss for souls entering the Kingdom of heaven.

Deep Impact – Brandon Powell, Student Mobilization Coordinator with Baptist on Mission shared a video on Deep Impact and explained the focus and outreach emphasis of their ministry. DI kids will be in Hendersonville June 12-16 and DI students will be here June 19-23. There are 13 service mission projects scheduled in the community with the DI students.

Habitat for Humanity – Kristin Boelter, Volunteer Manager for Habitat for Humanity in Hendersonville, shared a video of a home build by volunteers from First Baptist Church Hendersonville, DI students laying sod and landscaping at one of the home builds and a house dedication of two homes where FBCH and DI has worked. She shared with those present the vision and mission of Habitat for Humanity. She also brought a 2x4 that will be used in a house and asked those in attendance to write scripture and blessings on it.

Currie gave closing remarks, thanked attendees and participants and offered a call to respond.

2023 Annual Report

Introduction/Overview

Fruitland Baptist Bible College has educated and trained many pastors throughout North Carolina for more than 75 years. Over these many years FBBC has also trained many men and women whom God has called into ministry and missions around the state and the world. FBBC has graduates across the globe who are faithfully serving Christ and making a difference for the Kingdom of God. Fruitland has some great reasons for celebration for the 2022-2023 year:

- Student Activities
- Conferences
- Special Days
- Camps

Significant Accomplishments & Activities

- The 2023 Fruitland Graduation ceremony was held on September 9, 2023. Twenty-six students received the Associate of Religion/Christian Ministry degree. Nine students in the Hispanic program were awarded the Certificate of Christian leadership and Diploma in Christian Ministry. Dr. Luis Tejera, professor for the Hispanic Program, preached a wonderful Baccalaureate Sermon which encouraged everyone in attendance.
- Fruitland added the new position of Student Dean to our administrative staff in the Fall of 2022. Lisa Furstenburg was promoted to this position.
- A weekly devotion and prayer/encouragement lunch for female students was created.
- FBBC students also participated in a Softball Tournament.
- Fruitland also began, for the first time, the FBBC Student Intramurals starting with Flag Football.
- An Addiction Recovery Support Group for students who have struggled with addictions in the past was established in the Fall of 2022.



- Other activities for students included a Welcome-Back Student Bingo Mixer for new students and returning student for the Fall quarter; a Student Super Bowl Party; and a Part-time Employee Appreciation Recognition.
- Conferences hosted by FBBC include Women of Carolina Women's Conference; a Prayer Conference which met at Mud Creek Baptist Church; a Bible Conference in partnership with Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary; as well as the Carolina Baptist Association Semi-Annual Meeting/Meal.
- FBBC hosted a number of special days throughout the 2022-2023 calendar year: The 2022 Founders Day and Alumni Day; the Annual Fruitland Breakfast at the Convention; Perry Brindley was awarded our 2022-2023 Fruitland "Alumnus of the Year Award" and the 2022-2023 "Advancing Fruitland Award" went to all of the alumni and students of FBBC.
- FBBC hosted a number of camps during the past year: Camp Glow Worship night ; Deep Impact Kids Camp and, Deep Impact Students Camp (the 2nd and 3rd weeks respectively); the Clear-view Baptist Church and South Mountain Association Mission.
- Over the last year, Fruitland students participated in various mission trips. In November, they prepared backpacks for students in West Virginia and in December the students delivered the backpacks. Our students also participated in the Hendersonville Christmas Parade and shared the love of Christ the love of Christ with the citizens of Hendersonville.
- In 2022, FBBC was involved in 7 weeks of recruiting at the Be-Do-Tell camps in Caswell, North Carolina. These seven weeks of recruiting were very important for bringing new students to the campus. - God has truly blessed Fruitland Baptist Bible College throughout 2022-2023. Our students, staff, administration and faculty have worked together in a wonderful way to make this year a success. Dr. David Horton, President, is very thankful for the presence of the Lord on our campus and has some great plans and goals for the coming years.
